Re: Supplementary Multifamily Housing
Regulations

Dear Supervisor Feiner and Members of the Town Council:

The Town Board agenda for July 9 includes two resolutions concerning Supplementary Multifamily Housing Regulations, one of which proposes a change in legislation which we have not yet seen, and the other proposes a public hearing on the change for August 27th.

As we understand it, the proposed change in the law would directly affect the Central Avenue corridor, which as you know, bisects in substantial part the Edgemont community. This proposal is therefore a matter of substantial importance to Edgemont residents, and they should have an opportunity to learn about it and weigh in if they have concerns or suggested modifications.

Most Edgemont civic associations do not meet over the summer, thereby precluding their review and comment. In addition, many residents are away in August. The Edgemont Community Council therefore respectfully requests that this hearing be postponed to the September 24th Town Board meeting so that civic associations and residents can participate in this hearing.

I also request that you apprise me of your decision this week so that I can inform the ECC board and residents of your decision. Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter.
