Dear Neighbor and Voter:

The School Board Nominating Committee will hold an open meeting on Wednesday, January 24, 2007 at 8:00 pm in the Greenville School library (snow date January 25) for the purpose of receiving names of persons for nomination as candidates for election to the Board of Education of the Edgemont Union Free School District #6 at Greenburgh.

Three (3) vacancies on the Board of Education will be filled at the general election on Tuesday, May 15, 2007. These vacancies will be created by the expiration of the terms of office of Mr. Marc Schneider, Ms. Lisa Freund and Ms. Maggie Landau. Mr. Schneider and Ms. Freund have each served one term and will not seek another term. Ms. Landau will run for a second term. The School Board Nominating Committee invites you to actively participate in the nominating process by urging qualified residents of the community to seek nomination to the Board of Education and to attend the January 24, 2007 meeting.

Members of the Board of Education, in a strong spirit of volunteerism, serve without compensation. Members are required to attend two public Board meetings per month (more at budget time) and Executive Sessions and to undertake necessary preparation time. Membership on the Board of Education brings a solid sense of community involvement.

Nomination of a potential candidate to the Edgemont Board of Education must be made in a letter to me as Chair of the Committee and must be received before 8:00 pm on January 24, 2007. Nominating letters may also be presented in person at the open meeting held that evening. The letter may be written by any qualified voter of the Edgemont School District. However, no member or spouse of a member of the Nominating Committee may write a letter of nomination for any candidate. In addition to the name and address of the potential candidate, the letter must contain a brief biographical sketch, including the candidate's educational background, occupation, participation in civic affairs, length of residence in the Edgemont School District, the grade level of any children presently attending school in the District and/or the year of graduation of any children who have previously attended Edgemont schools. The letter must also contain a statement indicating that the potential candidate has consented to serve if nominated and elected. Under the by-laws of the School Board Nominating Committee any letter that fails to include these items cannot be accepted.
